BIS working class: There will be a BIS working class in addition to BIS, BIS veteran and BIS puppy. The dog must have obtained a CC from working class to be competing for BOB/BOS working class. Requirements for participation in working class: 1) Must have reached 15 months by the first day of the show. 2) Valid lure coursing license. 3) Completed at least three races which of at least one is an international (CACIL) race. It must be at least one year and one day between the first and last race. 4) The dog must have gained at least 67 points (CAC quality) in the three qualifying races. When entering, please note that dogs from countries outside Norway must attach a working class certificate (WCC) from its original country specifying that they have met the requirements for participation in working class. If the working class certificate (WCC) is not available by the deadline, the dog will be moved to Open class.

Binding registration. The Sighthound Speciality Show is held in accordance with the Norwegian Kennel Club show regulations. Reservation is made for change in judges.
